

# CONDUCT A SURVEY




Did you know the average Canadian uses 20 single-use batteries each year? In 2009, less than 5% of all the single-use batteries sold in Canada were recycled. In 2015, Ontario recycled 33% of what was available, the highest recycling rate in the Country! That's great, but there are still many people that do not know that they can recycle batteries or where to recycle them. See if you can help them out!

## Conduct a Survey

Ask 5 people questions about battery recycling. You may be surprised by what you learn. You may also find more batteries to recycle at your school!

If you come across someone that does not know about battery recycling or know where to recycle, tear away the last column and leave it with them so they can search for a recycling location on the RMC website.
